Like Jesus, we need to stop all that we are doing so that we can hear them express their deep longing to have their sight restored to them." How hard would it be for us to say "What do you want me to do for you?"







The Archbishop's Letter is on Synodality. What's that? It is "a method and process of discussion and participation in which the whole people of God can listen to the Holy Spirit and take part in the life and mission of the Church."

As the pastoral leader of the Church, Pope Francis recognizes that the Holy Spirit is within each of us. He emphasizes the important process of listening and accompanying people living in a particular reality, whether they be youth, women, families or those living in poverty. "Hearing what the Holy Spirit has to say to the Church can only happen through a deep, mutual interaction among the people of God at all levels." What's involved in Synodality? Listening, dialoguing, praying and discerning are the key activities at a synod. This letter was scheduled for last week but delayed due to children's enrolment Masses. Copies are available in the porch.
